The CS 17 is also a very capable light air and rowing performer, with its well-engineered rocker keeping the transom mostly out of the water, when properly trimmed.

The designer's experience, holding his own rowing against a boat highly reputed to be an excellent rower in the 2005 Everglades Challenge, lends him great confidence that little is given up at the bottom of the speed spectrum.
